The class has been learning about Geology in the current main lesson. Basalt has been a feature of this main lesson because of the interesting tessellations that it makes in the landscape. When basalt cools slowly it forms interesting hexagonal shapes, some of which become exposed as rock pillars. The Organ Pipes National Park is Melbourne's closest national park and is situated to the north of Tullamarine Airport, and is an excellent example of basalt geological formations.

On Tuesday 6th June the class will travel by bus from school to the park to draw the interesting tessellations in their main lesson books as the culmination of the main lesson block. Your child will need to be in full school uniform, but also bring warm clothes, a snack and their lunch.
