

## COMMUNITY MARKET

### Purpose

To bring the school community together in a social setting.

To provide the students, parents and any other interested person with a venue for selling home made food, goods and services.

To provide the children with opportunities to develop real- life maths and social skills when they decide to have a stall

### Broad Guidelines

- Food needs to be home made
- No highly processed food to be sold.
- Food safety standards need to be met- as per guidelines in *Food Act 1984*.
- Food servers must wear gloves if handling food.

### Implementation

- Market coordinator to ensure all food stall handlers are provided with and are wearing gloves and must not also handle money- another person is required on the stall to do this.
- Tables need to be booked.
- Tables need to be packed away by the person holding the stall at the end of the market.
- 10% of the takings need to be donated to the school as goodwill.
- Stall holders to supply their own 'kitty' of change.

### Evaluation

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Education Committee and will involve listening to comments made by the community.
